Convention Costs

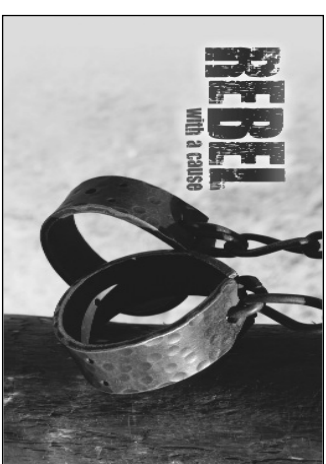
Adults: \$20 for one person or **\$35** for two adults in one household
